Great Deals in Wine

The Maremma Appellation in Tuscany is still a bit under-the-radar for most wine lovers, which is why now is a great time to explore the offerings. Varietals from Canaiolo and Merlot to Vermentino and Chardonnay are cultivated in Maremma's diversity of soils and climate. Two to try: Argentaia Col di Lupo, Maremma Toscana, 2017 (a ripe, fruity Sangiovese and Merlot blend) & Mazzei Tenuta Belguardo Maremma Toscana, 2017 (a polished, silky red blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc.)
